Crash Synopsis:

On 06/18/2026 at 2325 hours, Troopers stationed out of the Pennsylvania State Police barracks in DuBois arrived on scene at a three-vehicle crash on Interstate 80 near the 98.5 MM E/B located in DuBois City, Clearfield County, PA. Unit #3 was traveling East in the right lane while Unit #2 was traveling beside it in the left lane. Unit #1 was traveling behind Unit #3 in the right lane. While all three vehicles were traveling at this location, Unit #1 merged from the right lane to the left lane and struck Unit #2's trailing unit at the eleven-

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o'clock position. This caused Unit #2 to abruptly swerve to the right and into Unit #3 at the nine o'clock position. All three units sustained minor damage. There were no injuries reported as a result of this crash. One (1) traffic citation was filed against Operator #1 for a violation of VC3334(a).

Crash Synopsis:

On 06/15/2026 at 1722 hours, Troopers stationed out of the Pennsylvania State Police barracks in DuBois were dispatched to a one-vehicle crash on Interstate 80 at the 106.0 MM E/B located in Union Township, Clearfield County, PA. Unit #1 was traveling East at that location in the left lane and struck debris on the roadway believed to have come from a commercial vehicle. This collision resulted in damage to Unit #1's undercarriage and both the front and rear driver side tires. After the collision, Unit #1 came to final rest along the left side shoulder facing East. Operator #1 was not injured. There were no citations filed as a result of this crash. I was assisted on scene by Mottman towing.
