Crash Synopsis:

On 06/22/2026, at approximately 1045 hours, a single-vehicle crash occurred on Old Grade Road. Old Grade Road is a two-lane, asphalt-paved roadway running north and south through Winslow Township, Jefferson County. Unit 1, a blue 2015 Mitsubishi Outlander, was traveling southbound when the operator lost control on the wet roadway surface. Unit 1 traveled off the left side of the roadway for approximately 30 yards before striking a tree. The vehicle rotated approximately 180 degrees from the force of the impact, coming to a final rest on the eastern roadside. The operator sustained minor injuries and was transported to Penn Highlands DuBois via EMS. Unit 1 sustained disabling damage and was towed from the scene.
