This two-vehicle crash occurred on I83 S at the ramp to I283 S, Swatara Township, Dauphin County. Unit 1 is a permitted oversize load with a trailing Unit. Unit 2 is a Semi trailer truck. This portion of roadway is two lanes with the left lane going to I283S and the right lane continuing on I83S. Unit 2 was in the left lane approaching the ramp for I283S. Unit 1 was in the right lane and unsafely changed to the left lane in front of Unit 2. Unit 2 was unable to stop in time. Unit 1 impacted Unit 2 in Unit 2's 10 o'clock position with Unit 1's 7 o'clock position. After impact Unit 2 was pushed to the right shoulder and impacted the concrete barrier. Unit 1 came to a controlled final rest on the right shoulder of the entrance ramp to I283S. Unit 1 sustained minor damage to the rear driver side tire of the trailing Unit. Unit 2 came to a final rest on the left shoulder, partial blocking the entrance ramp to I283S. Unit 2 sustained disabling damage to the passenger side wheel axel and was towed from the scene. No injuries were reported on scene.

This crash occurred on 07/06/2026 at approximately 1250 hours on the PA 581 E off ramp to Carlisle Pike, Hampden Township, Cumberland County. This crash occurred as Unit 1 was fleeing from Hampden Township PD at a high rate of speed traveling west on Carlisle Pike. Operator 1 attempted to negotiate a right curve to flee on the PA 581 W off ramp, lost control of Unit 1, and subsequently struck stopped Unit 2 on the PA 581 E off ramp. Due to the impact between Unit 1 and Unit 2, Unit 2 was pushed into stopped Units 3 and 4. Operator 2 and his passengers sustained injuries as a result of this crash and were transported to Holy Spirit Medical Center by Hampden Township EMS. Units 1 and 2 were towed by GA Smith Towing for disabling damage. Units 3 and 4 were capable of leaving the scene.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 and Unit 2 were traveling South on I81 in the area of mile marker 69.0, Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County. At this time, Unit 1 was directly behind Unit 2 in the center lane. Unit 1 failed to maintain a reasonable distance behind Unit 2 during heavy traffic conditions. Unit 1 subsequently struck Unit 2 from the rear. Unit 1 and Unit 2 came to a controlled final rest on the right shoulder. Unit 1 sustained functional damage to the front bumper. Unit 2 sustained functional damage in the form of scratch marks to the rear bumper. Unit 1 and Unit 2 were able to be driven off the shoulder under their own power. No injuries were reported as a result of this crash.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 and Unit 2 were traveling South on I81 in the area of mile marker 65.5, Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County. At this time, Unit 1 was in the left lane and Unit 2 was in the center lane. Unit 1 failed to clear the adjacent lane to her right and began conducting an unsafe lane change. Unit 1 subsequently struck the 11 o'clock position of Unit 2 with the 5 o'clock position of Unit 1. Unit 1 and Unit 2 came to a controlled final rest on the right shoulder. Unit 1 sustained functional damage to the rear passenger side quarter panel and rear passenger side rim. Unit 2 sustained functional damage to the front push bumper on the front driver side. Unit 1 and Unit 2 were able to be driven off the right shoulder under their own power. No injuries were reported as a result of this crash.
