### Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit #1 was traveling north along Forsht Drive in Duncansville Borough, Blair County. Unit #1 began traveling into the oncoming lane where Unit #2 was traveling southbound. Unit #2 attempted to avoid Unit #1 by moving the right, but Unit #1 struck Unit #2 at the left front quarter panel. Unit #1 continued off of the roadway to the west and struck a fence. Unit #1 then came to final rest within a wetland. Unit #2 came to final rest along the roadway facing north.

Operator #1 is believed to have suffered a major medical event rendering him unable to control his vehicle. Operator #1 was pronounced dead at the scene.
