Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling south on Smith valley Rd, Union Twp, Huntingdon County. As Unit 1 was traveling south it overcompensate for a right hand curve. Unit 1 traveled into the north bound lane of Smith Valley rd, and left the roadway on the east side. Unit 1 was laid on its side where it struck the embankment causing the operator to be ejected. The operator continued down the embankment where he struck a tree and came to final rest at the bank of the Smith Valley River. Unit 1 came to final rest in the Smith Valley River.

Crash Synopsis:

This single vehicle fatal crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling west near 7280 Shavers Creek Road (SR 305), Logan Township, Huntingdon County, PA. As Unit 1 was traveling west on Shavers Creek Road, Unit 1 traveled off of the right (north) side of the roadway. Unit 1 subsequently struck a slight embankment on the north side of the roadway, before coming to final rest in a cornfield, facing northeast. The Operator of Unit 1 sustained fatal injuries as a result of the crash. Assisted on scene by Petersburg Fire and EMS, the Huntingdon County Coroners Office and Derek's Towing.
