Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling north on McConnel Road. As Unit 1 was traveling north, Unit 1 was attempting to turn left into its driveway. Unit 1 proceeded to turn too early and subsequently drove off the western side of McConnel Road. Unit 1's 11 o'clock position subsequently struck a tree. Unit 1 proceeded to come into final rest into a tree. Upon my arrival on scene, I observed Unit 1 at final rest on the western side of McConnel Road into a tree. I observed disabling damage to the 11,12, and 1 o'clock position of Unit 1. I observed the Operator of Unit 1 inside of Unit 1. Operator of Unit 1 was unable to get out of the car due to old age. The Operator of Unit 1 was being assisted by Tunnelton Volunteer VFD and Murrysville EMS. The Operator of Unit 1 was transported to IRMC for medical evaluation. No damage was observed to surrounding properties. Assisted on scene by Tunnelton VFD, Murrysville EMS, and Bob Hafers Towing.
