8. INCIDENT DETAILS

On 07/10/2026 at 0729 hours, Troopers from the Jonestown Station responded to the above location for the report of a 5-year-old male child found naked walking in the middle of the road. Troopers responded to the scene and met with the good Samaritans who were able to hold the child until Troopers and EMS arrived. The 5-year-old male child was transported to Welspan Good Samaritan Hospital for a medical evaluation. Troopers identified a nearby residence located at 2 N Poplar Street, Swatara Township, Lebanon County where the male child escaped from. Hoarder conditions were observed throughout the house, with trash throughout, hundreds of flies observed, and limited room for maneuvering the house because of the influx of clutter. There was one bedroom that was observed to have a baby gate affixed to the outside of the door frame, that was being held together by numerous zip ties and duct tape. This bedroom was later identified as the male child's bedroom. Above the baby gate, there was miscellaneous wood boards drilled into the outside of the door frame to prevent the male child from escaping the bedroom. Feces was observed to be smeared on the walls, feces smeared on the bedroom window, a bed was observed to be torn apart with food all over it, trash was observed on the floor, hundreds of flies flying around the bedroom and the residence, along with various children's toys scattered throughout. The above listed ARRESTEE's were taken into custody and charged with one count of Title 18 CC 4304 – Endangering Welfare of Children through district court 52-3-03.
