**Crash Synopsis:**

This crash occurred on the 8000 block of Alexandria Street, Derry Township, Westmoreland County. At this location, Alexandria Street is a two-lane asphalt roadway that traverses north and south with no roadway markings designating separation on the roadway. This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traversing southbound on Alexandria Street. Operator 1 is believed to have suffered from a mental episode causing Operator 1 to lose control of Unit 1. Unit 1 left its designated lane of travel leaving the roadway on the right-hand side. Unit 1 then hit a utility pole where it came to an uncontrolled final rest. Upon Unit 1 hitting the Utility Pole the pole was completely sheared causing it to collapse onto the fence of the residence of 2097 Alexandria Street. Unit 1 was towed from scene by Gombach Towing. Operator 1 was transported to Latrobe Hospital by EMS.

This crash occurred on N Chestnut Street at its intersection with E Keeling Ave and W Keeling Ave, Derry Borough, Westmoreland County. At this location, N Chestnut Street is a two-lane asphalt roadway that traverses east and west separated by double yellow lines. E Keeling Ave and W Keeling Ave are both asphalt roadways that traverse north and south with no roadway markings designating separation on the roadway. This crash occurred as Unit 1 and Unit 2(Pedestrian) was traveling westbound on N Chestnut Street. As Unit 2 was hand signaling to turn left onto W Keeling Ave, Unit 1 attempted to pass Unit 2. Unit 1 then hit Unit 2 in the intersection of N Chestnut Street at its intersection with E Keeling Ave and W Keeling Ave. Unit 2(Pedestrian) was transported to Forbes Hospital by EMS.
