**Crash Synopsis:**

This crash occurred on Kohlersburg Road Eastbound near State Route 28 and 66, South Bethlehem Borough, Armstrong County, PA. Unit 1 was traveling on Kohlersburg Road Eastbound. Unit 1 traveled into the Westbound lane and continued to travel off the roadway. Unit 1 struck a tree and continued to travel until coming to final rest. Unit 1 sustained disabling damage to the 11 o'clock position. Unit 1 was removed from the scene and transported to the PSP Kittanning barracks by Cornman's Towing.

INCIDENT DETAILS:

On the above date and time, Troopers from PSP Kittanning responded to the above location for a utility terrain vehicle (UTV) crash. This crash occurred when the UTV driven by Daniel POWELL went off the dirt trail they were on, and rolled approximately 300 yards down the hillside. This was witness by other riders in a separate UTV who called 911. Passengers Tristen HOFFMAN and Krystin CORBETT were able to get back up the hillside and were then extricated off the trail by the fire department's UTV. HOFFMAN sustained a minor head injury and refused EMS. CORBETT was transported by EMS to Armstrong County Memorial Hospital and then flown via life-flight to Allegheny General Hospital. Fire Department were able to extract POWELL by rope up the hillside and was then also flown by life flight to Allegheny General Hospital.

CORBETT and POWELL were unable to be interviewed at this time. This investigation is on going.

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
