## 8. INCIDENT DETAILS

On 04/26/2026, at 0116 hours, Trooper(s) responded to Niki's Quick Six, located at 1024 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Parks Township, Armstrong County, for the report of shots fired. Kiskiminetas Patrol Officer Aaron ARTZ was the first officer on scene. Upon officer arrival, one deceased female and multiple gunshot victims were identified. The Deceased, Jessica HILLIARD, W/N-F-34, of Apollo, PA, and gunshot victim, Rebecca BOSTON, W/N-F-24, of McIntyre, PA were located at the scene. The additional gunshot victims, Hector SABALLOS, W/H-M-34, of Vandergrift, PA, and Dominik DELLACH, W/N-M-25, of Vandergrift, PA, left the scene prior to Trooper(s) arrival. The Accused, David DUNMIRE, W/N-M-36, of Vandergrift, PA, remained on the scene and was taken into custody without incident. Trooper(s) secured the scene and assumed responsibility of the criminal investigation. The Armstrong County District Attorney's Office along with the Armstrong County Coroner's Office were notified. Upon further investigation, it was determined that a physical altercation occurred in the parking lot outside Nikki's Quick Six. After the altercation, DUNMIRE produced a firearm and fired multiple rounds, striking several victims. HILLIARD was pronounced deceased at the scene. BOSTON is currently listed in critical condition, while SABALLOS and DELLACH are currently listed in stable condition. Trooper(s) consulted with Armstrong County District Attorney Katie CHARLTON who approved Criminal Homicide charges. Investigation is ongoing.
