Unit 1 traveled approximately 300 ft west, struck an embankment (MM195 crossover), then a gate, coming to its final resting on the west side of the crossover facing west.

Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred at the 4-way intersection of PPL Road, Muncy Exchange Road, and White Hall Road in Anthony Township, Montour County, PA. Unit 1 was traveling north on PPL Road approaching the intersection with the above-mentioned roadways. Unit 1 did not obey the properly posted stop sign at the 4-way intersection, and continued through the intersection. Unit 1 also began to travel off the west side of the roadway at this time, then striking a telephone pole, a stop sign, and mailboxes on the west side of Muncy Exchange Road. After the points of impact, Unit 1 traveled approximately 30 feet before coming to final rest. Minor injuries were reported on scene by Operator 1, but EMS was declined when offered. Operator 1 was wearing a seat belt at the time of the crash, and the front air bag was deployed.

Unit 1 was traveling at approx. 40 mph at which point operator 1 lost control and struck the dirt embankment off of the east shoulder with unit 1's 12 o'clock position. Unit 1 then continued North for approx. 25 yards at which point Unit 1 came to final rest off the west bound shoulder of County line road, Lewis Twp., Northumberland Co. Unit 1 sustained disabling damage and all air bags were deployed. Operator 1 sustained suspected minor injuries and was transported to Geisinger Danville by EMS.
