This crash occurred as Unit 1 was traveling northbound on SR0219 in the area of 2667 Mahaffey Grampian Highway attempting to go through a right-hand curve. As Unit 1 was in the middle of the turn, Operator 1 lost control of Unit 1. Unit 1 then crossed the double yellow line and Unit 1 spun around where the front end of Unit 1 was facing the right-hand side of the roadway. As this occurred Unit 1 went completely off the left side of the roadway and impacted a ditch. Unit 1 continued along the ditch until the embankment was steep enough to stop the momentum of Unit 1. This was Unit 1's final resting position. This crash was a result of Unit 1 traveling too fast for conditions. Unit 1 had to be towed from the scene of the crash. Operator 1 was not injured in the crash.
