8. INCIDENT DETAILS <p>This crash occurred on North Eagle Valley Road just south of Swartz Hollow Road, Howard Township, Centre County. One vehicle was traveling NB and the other SB at this location. Evidence at the scene indicates both vehicles crossed the center line resulting in a head on collision. Front airbags were deployed on both Units. The driver and two passengers of the Pontiac succumbed to their injuries sustained in the crash. Two passengers from the Pontiac were flown from the scene for life threatening injuries.
