Crash Synopsis:

On 01/07/2026, at approximately 1835 hours, members of Pennsylvania State Police, Uniontown Barracks were dispatched to a rear-end type collision on National Pike near its intersection with Lick Hollow Road, South Union Township, Fayette County, PA. This crash occurred as Unit 1, a van operated by Michael DURITSKY, was traveling east on National Pike. While traveling east, Unit 1 struck Unit 2, a commercial vehicle, at a high rate of speed in a rear-end type collision. Operator 1 was pronounced deceased at the scene at approximately 1841 hours. The investigation is on-going.
