MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter is before the Professional Standards and Practices Commission (“Commission”) upon the Department of Education’s (“Department”) Motion for Entry of Order, which seeks acknowledgment of the Respondent’s surrender of her professional educator certification certificate and requests dismissal of the instant disciplinary action.

Initially, the Department filed a Notice of Charges against Respondent on July 20, 2009, seeking the immediate suspension of the Respondent’s professional educator certification under 24 P.S. §2070.9b(1)¹. The Commission entered an order on August 25, 2009, immediately suspending the Respondent’s certification, finding that the Respondent had been criminally charged with several offenses, including Discussing Explicit Sexual Material with a Minor (18 Pa. C.S. §5903(c)(1)), Contact/Communication with a Minor – Sexual Offenses (18 Pa. C.S. §6318(a)(1)), and Corruption of Minors (18 Pa. C.S. §6301(a)(1)) and that she posed a danger to the health, safety or welfare of a student or other individual in a school.

¹ Section 9b(1) provides for immediate suspension of the certification of a professional educator who is indicted for a crime set forth in section 111(e)(1) through (3) of the Public School Code of 1949 when the Commission determines that the professional educator poses a threat to the health, safety or welfare of a

Subsequently, the Respondent agreed to relinquish her Pennsylvania Instructional II teaching certificate in the area of English 7-12 and her rights to any other Pennsylvania teaching certificates that may have been issued to her. In consideration of the Department's Motion for Entry of Order and the Respondent's Affidavit of Surrender, the Commission has decided to grant the Motion and, accordingly, enters the following:
