Pennsylvania Disaster Recovery Assistance Program (DRAP) Eligible Essential Personal Property (Category 3)

For eligible homeowners and renters, DRAP funds may be used to cover the loss of essential personal property destroyed due to the disaster and not covered by insurance. Essential personal property not covered by insurance is eligible under DRAP for reimbursement up to \$7,5000.
