



Damage from fire?

You may be eligible for help.

Disaster Recovery Assistance Program - DRAP

The Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency has made the Commonwealth Disaster Recovery Assistance Program (DRAP) available to residents recovering from the fire at the Oak Forest Apartments, in Muhlenberg Township, Berks County. The fire occurred on June 11, 2026.

Those who meet DRAP grant criteria may receive a one-time grant of up to \$15,000 per household to assist with:



Temporary Housing - If you own or rent your home. Covers temporary lodging or rental assistance for household members and pets if you are unable to live in your home due to damage.



Essential Personal Property - If you own or rent your home. Money to help replace certain essential personal property damaged by the fire.


Is DRAP for YOU?

If you answer "YES" to all questions below, you may be able to get DRAP assistance:

- Is your primary residence at the Oak Forest Apartments, 2251 or 2271 Hampden Blvd., Reading, PA 19604?
- Did you suffer damages from the June 11, 2026, fire at Oak Forest Apartments?
- Is your household income (everyone who lives in the home) less than 500% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines? (See chart on the next page)
- Do you currently receive income-based government assistance? If not, have you applied for an SBA Disaster Loan for this event and been denied (due to an inability to repay or in adequate credit)? The SBA Disaster Loan deadline is August 24, 2026.
