Upon **MOTION** by **Ms. Pike-Nase**, and **SECONDED** by **Mr. Smith**, and approved unanimously by the SPSBA Board, it was **RESOLVED** that the Board adopted the Agenda for the April 25, 2024, Board Meeting.

## 4. APPROVAL OF PROJECTS

## A. Resolution Authorizing the Undertaking of a Project on Behalf of the Community College of Beaver County

The Community College of Beaver County (the "College") has requested that the State Public School Building Authority (the "Authority") issue a maximum of \$20,000,000 in revenue bonds to finance various capital improvements including an educational facility and a terminal building, for the College's School of Aviation Sciences and the payment of the costs and expenses of issuing and insuring the 2024 bonds.

The College has selected Stifel Nicolaus & Company, Inc. as underwriter. At the request of the College, the Office of General Counsel has appointed Dinsmore & Shohl LLP as bond counsel. Hardwick Law Firm, LLC will serve as SDB and John A. Schwab, Attorney at Law, will serve as VBE.

The Resolution in your agenda approves all actions necessary in connection with the issuance of the Bonds.

Dennis Zeh from the College, John McShane from Stifel Nicolaus & Company, Inc., and bond counsel from Dinsmore & Shohl LLP are available to answer any questions.

## RESOLUTION OF THE STATE PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE UNDERTAKING OF A PROJECT ON BEHALF OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF BEAVER COUNTY

## DOCKET NO. 2515

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The State Public School Building Authority (the "Authority") will undertake the financing of a project (the "Project") for Community College of Beaver County (the "College") consisting of (a) various capital improvements including, but not limited to, an educational facility and a terminal building, for the benefit of the College's School of Aviation Sciences; and (b) the payment of the costs and expenses of issuing and insuring the Bonds, by the issuance of one or more series of the Authority's College Revenue Bonds (Community College of Beaver County Project) Series of 2024 in a principal amount not to exceed \$20,000,000 (the "2024 Bonds").

2. In order to finance the Project, the Authority will enter into a supplemental Indenture (as subsequently defined) with the Trustee herein appointed, and will issue the 2024 Bonds in one or more series in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$20,000,000. The 2024 Bonds will be issued as serial or term bonds and will have a final maturity on December 1, 2044, will bear interest at fixed rates acceptable to the College, and will be subject to redemption prior to their maturity dates as provided in the 2024 Bonds, all as approved by the Executive Director in consultation with the College, and as further provided in a bond purchase agreement, hereinafter described.

The 2024 Bonds will be issued in such denominations and form and with such terms as shall be set forth in a supplemental Trust Indenture between the Authority and the Trustee herein appointed to be dated as of the date of issuance of the 2024 Bonds, and approved by the Executive Director (the "Indenture"). The Bonds shall be issued as Additional Bonds under the Trust Indenture dated as of November 12, 2020 between the Authority and U.S. Bank National Association. The execution of the 2024 Bonds with the manual or facsimile signature of the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as the President of the Authority, or any Vice President of the Authority together with the official seal and the manual or facsimile signature of the Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Authority is hereby authorized. The Executive Director of the Authority is hereby authorized to deliver the 2024 Bonds to the Trustee under the Indenture for authenticated, on behalf of the Authority, to or upon the order of the purchaser thereof, against receipt of the purchase price together with any accrued interest, all in accordance with the requirements of the Indenture.

3. The proceeds from the sale of the 2024 Bonds will be loaned to the College pursuant to the terms of a supplemental Loan Agreement between the Authority and the College (herein referred to as the "Loan Agreement"), and shall be applied by the College for and toward the costs of the Project and the payment of the costs and expenses of issuing and insuring the 2024 Bonds.

The Authority and the College had previously entered into a Loan Agreement dated as of November 12, 2020.

4. The President, any Vice President or the Executive Director of the Authority is hereby authorized on behalf of the Authority to enter into a purchase agreement for the 2024 Bonds, in a form and with content acceptable to the Authority and the College (the "Bond Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to a private sale as requested by the College, for the purchase of the 2024 Bonds, issued in accordance with the terms of this Resolution, and the President, any Vice President, the Secretary or any Assistant Secretary, or the Executive Director of the Authority is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Bond Purchase Agreement on behalf of the Authority and to take such further action as he or she deems necessary or advisable to carry out the obligations of the Authority thereunder.

5. The Authority does hereby authorize the execution and delivery of the following documents relating to the issuance of the 2024 Bonds and the financing of the Project: an Indenture, a Loan Agreement, the Bond Purchase Agreement and any other document required in connection with the issuance of the 2024 Bonds and the financing of the Project (together, the "Authority Documents"), all in such form as shall be acceptable to Bond Counsel (as hereinafter defined), the Attorney General of the Commonwealth, the Office of General Counsel, and Authority Counsel and as shall be approved by the Executive Director of the Authority.

6. The President, the Vice President or the Executive Director of the Authority, and each of them is hereby authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver in the name and on behalf of the Authority, and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary and each of them, is hereby authorized to attest and affix the official seal of the Authority to each of the Authority Documents. The execution of the aforesaid documents as hereinabove authorized shall be deemed to conclusively evidence the approval by the Authority of the Authority Documents.

7. Any preliminary official statement or final official statement which may be used in connection with the offer and sale of the 2024 Bonds shall be in such form as shall be approved, solely as to, and for the purposes of, distribution, by the Executive Director of the Authority with the advice of Bond Counsel (as hereinafter defined). The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute any such preliminary official statement or final official statement in the name and on behalf of the Authority, and such execution by the Executive Director of the Authority shall constitute conclusive evidence of the Authority's approval, solely as to, and for the purposes of, distribution, of such documents. The circulation and distribution of copies of any such documents in connection with the offer and sale of the 2024 Bonds is hereby authorized.

8. The Underwriter, Stifel Nicolaus & Company, Inc., is hereby authorized to purchase the 2024 Bonds upon the terms and conditions contained in the Bond Purchase Agreement. U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association (or other Trustee acceptable to the College) (the "Trustee") shall be and hereby is authorized to act as Trustee under the Indenture in connection with the issuance of the 2024 Bonds. At the request of the College, the Office of General Counsel has appointed Dinsmore & Shohl LLP as bond counsel for this issuance ("Bond Counsel").

9. The appropriate officers of the Authority are hereby authorized to take such further action and to execute and deliver in the name and on behalf of the Authority any and all other documents and certificates, including a Tax Certificate or Agreement (the "Tax Certificate") in addition to those specified above, as they shall deem necessary or advisable in connection with the issuance of the 2024 Bonds and the implementation of this Resolution.

10. The appropriate officers of the Authority, including the President, the Vice President and the Executive Director are, and each of them is, hereby authorized to approve, and to execute and deliver any supplement, amendment or other agreement providing for a trust indenture, loan agreement, bond, note, instrument or other document to be executed and delivered with respect to the financing of the Project or any amendment to an existing agreement relating to a financing by the Authority for the College (collectively, the "Amendment") requested by the College and approved by all other necessary parties, provided that (a) the officer executing such Amendment shall have determined that the Amendment will not adversely affect the Authority, such determination to be conclusively evidenced by such officer's execution of an Amendment, and (b) the Authority shall have received an opinion of counsel in form and substance satisfactory to the Authority that (i) the Amendment is permitted under the Act, and (ii) the Amendment will not adversely affect the excludability from gross income of interest on the 2024 Bonds for purposes of federal income taxation.

11. The Trustee shall be, by virtue of this Resolution and without further authorization from the Authority, authorized, directed and requested to invest and reinvest all moneys available therefor pursuant to the Indenture, which by the terms of such Indenture may be invested, or to deposit and redeposit such moneys in such accounts as may be permitted by the Indenture, all subject to the terms and limitations contained in the Indenture.

12. The appropriate officers of the Authority are, and each of them is, hereby authorized to execute and deliver in the name and on behalf of the Authority such other documents and to take such other action as they shall deem necessary in order to effectuate the financing of the Project, the execution, delivery and receipt of the Indenture, the Loan Agreement, the Bond Purchase Agreement or any Amendment, and the issuance and sale of the 2024 Bonds, all in accordance with this Resolution.

13. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, and all prior resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Upon **MOTION** by **Ms. Pike-Nase**, and **SECONDED** by **Mr. Smith**, and after full discussion, the above Resolution was unanimously approved at the SPSBA Board Meeting of April 25, 2024.
